

MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD IN THE CHAMBER OF DEPUTY DIRECTOR (SS) ON 10th JANUARY, 2023 AT 1100 HOURS REGARDING ALLOTMENT OF DRY DOCK AND SLIPWAY SLOT.

At the outset, the Deputy Director (SS)/Marine Engineer welcomed the members and deliberated in detail the utilization of Dry Dock & Slipway Slots. It was also discussed concurring urgent application of paint scheme and underwater survey On Board MV Rajhans to be carried out on urgent basis which was agreed by the committee and recommended that after Un-Docking of MV Rajhans, Old Dry Dock may be allotted to the following vessels consecutively.

From the above list it is found that M/s. 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

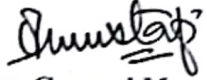
